

The October meeting of the Area 67 Literature Committee was called to order with the Serenity Prayer at 7:31 p.m. Oct. 21, 2025. Present were Committee Chair Jim M., Alt Committee Chair Carol F, Area Literature Secretary Shea; Steffanie, Secretary Area IT, and District 31 Literature Rep.; Dallas, Literature chair SISTX; Kris of SIS TX, intergroup delegate,. Caitlin, District 40 literature rep., John District 82 PI rep., Bambi, Literature Chair, Katy 164 group, and Ann, SISTX alt lit rep.

Jim read the statement of purpose.

The minutes from the July meeting were approved as presented.

Jim reported that Steffanie did a great job presenting for the Literature Committee at the Fall Area 67 Assembly. She used a big trifold she had used for another presentation and discussed the literature available for service committees.

He said the AAWS quarterly report on Literature states that there will be an audio version of the Plan Language Big Book and that more than 1,300 correctional facilities are using the book on tablets.

Jim mentioned that the Literature Committee now has a folder on the SETA google drive which can serve as a repository for the power points various members of the group put together. The presentations can be used on an A/V screen at future conventions and assemblies. Jim thanked the group for their work.

Jim also reported that Sara, District 70 DCM, has asked that a representative of the committee attend their district meeting to help get GSRs interested in literature. The district meeting is the second Wednesday of the month and Jim plans to set up the date and attend and invited any committee member to join him in Pasadena.

Steffanie, who is on the IT area IT committee as well as the Literature committee, explained that the google drive folder is available to those who have a SETA gmail account. She said the folder is a good repository for minutes, agendas and new presentation. She said she would upload the old agendas and minutes which she had access to.

She also noted that the SETA website is full of information. There are committees for many service areas and there is literature and information for all of those committees.

Jim announced that we will not be selling literature at the SETA convention in Beaumont in January but will have a display at the convention.

Committee members discussed some ways they are using literature in meetings and with sponsees. It was noted that on aa.org, any brochure can be uploaded.

The next meeting will be held Nov. 18, 2025 on Google Meets.
