**STEP 8:** Made a list of all persons we had harmed, and became willing to make amends to them all.

**TRADITION 8** (LONG FORM): Alcoholics Anonymous should remain forever non-professional. We define professionalism as the occupation of counseling alcoholics for fees or hire. But we may employ alcoholics where they are going to perform those services for which we may otherwise have to engage nonalcoholics. Such special services may be well recompensed. But our usual A.A. "12 Step" work is never to be paid for.

**CONCEPT 8** (SHORT FORM): The trustees are the principal planners and administrators of over-all policy and finance. They have custodial oversight of the separately incorporated and constantly active services, exercising this through their ability to elect all the directors of these entities.

A. Frequently volunteers are get disenchanted and just didn't show up which can mean the club is left open unattended and calls might not get answered.
An AA member hired to perform this functions is making Twelfth Step work possible. It is a service proposition, pure and simple. *Page 167 - 168*

Q. Every time we have tried to professionalize our Twelfth Step, the result has been exactly the same. What is the result.

A. Our single purpose has been defeated. Page 170
