- Alternate Treasurer Opening
 - ★ Kate M offered her service to serve as D31 Alternate Treasurer and voting members in attendance unanimously voted yes to her offer. Effective immediately.
- Alt Delegate Christina S. attended to discuss selected Agenda items for 74th GSC 2024
 - She opened her discussion with a brief overview of the agenda and how the 74th GSO meeting is scheduled for our delegates.
 - She gave a good review of the proposed "Plain Language BB"
 - o Spirited discussion was held.
 - o Taylor (from the floor) clarified for many in the room that the Plain Language BB is NOT a replacement for the BB as we know ii. Instead he likened it to having it printed in different languages. But instead of French, Spanish, etc.. it is being printed with the 'plain' language written at a 5th grade reading comprehension level.
 - THIS DOES NOT REPLACE BB
 - 5th Edition: 164 pages remain unchanged, Dr. Bob and Doctors Opinion unchanged. Adding a preface as previous printing and updating stories. (Currently reviewing over 2500 stories submitted)
 - o Discussion about proposing a POLICY to GSO that founders writings cannot be changed.
 - Christina answered many questions and then referred all to the SETA Delegate page and invited all with comments/concerns to attend ASSEMBLY and participate in area roundtables.
