

Peggy – GSR- the ladies in her group will be going to look at Christmas lights and having a meal together. She also stated that her group is small and that all are welcome to attend.

David -Wild West Group- will have their regular meetings on December 25th and January 1st at 6:30 pm at COTHA.

Amanda – The God Group will have their regular meeting on December 24th and December 31st at 9:30 am. Also the Journey Group will be having their 40th anniversary in January.

Topic: Look over and discuss the D31 GSR Handbook (see attached) and see what stands out and what we might want to use.

Discussion:

Marilyn – through chat - there was a suggestion to use first and last name when introducing yourself. Odd since there was a suggestion to vote exactly like group voted. What if GSR gets additional information at Seta? What about Right of Decision? Odd to suggest use first and last name since we are anonymous. Good topics to discuss. Opportunity to discuss and learn, use both names and Right of Decision. Marilyn stated she went to a webinar where the GSB Treasurer said groups have stopped sending money to GSO because of lack of transparency with GSB. Lack of accountability, cost containment and how board resignations were handled. People asked the Treasurer what the plan was to pay bills and restore the prudent reserve. His response was to send more money. He also said that groups could email the GSB with reasons why they were using the Power of the Purse. You can go to aa.org, select finance and send your email.

Farah – personal opinion, will use first name and last name initial only.

General Sharing Session

Peggy stated a concern from her group and others with the \$1M(one million dollar) deficit at GSO. There is controversy with the Plain Language Book and the lack of transparency. Bob at GSO said there was a drop in literature sales. Concern that Farah's PAI was rejected.

Q. Should we talk to Rick? Can we find out what other districts think?

Farah stated that GSO did not fully read the PAI, they thought it was an audit concerning numbers but it's really about processes. She heard GSO had too many PAIs.
