Robert Holbrook Smith (Dr. Bob) dies at age 71 with 15 years sobriety. Bill Wilson called him the "Prince of Twelfth Steppers" because he helped more than 5000 alcoholics before his death. His home was named a National Historic Landmark in 1985 and is visited by thousands of AAs each year. [Dr. Bob's Home](#) is a nonprofit organization that maintains and preserves the property to educate visitors and honor the AA co-founder's legacy of love and service.

November 1975

Lois W. and Archive Committee Trustee Tom S. cut a blue ribbon to officially open the AA Archives at GSO New York. The first archivist was nonalcoholic Nell Wing, who served as Bill W.'s secretary for 20 years.
