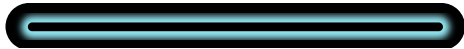

CONCEPT ONE

Final responsibility and ultimate authority for A.A. world services should always reside in the collective conscience of our whole fellowship.

Initially, in 1948, Dr. Bob & Bill W. were the "ultimate authority" and advisors to a group named as Trustees, whose job it was to advise The General Service Board of A.A. (so named in 1954, previously called "The Alcoholic Foundation").

This group was designed to initiate and maintain the special services of A.A. as a whole, for example: translating literature into other languages, providing literature to individual groups around the world, guidance to questions from our members.

Through the process of defining what this group would do, it was decided that there would be Group Service Representatives (GSRs) elected by each group who meet with area Delegates. These GSRs would then have ultimate authority in deciding the needs of A.A.

Linked with Tradition Two, the General Service Board is to A.A. as Tradition Two is to the individual group.

In today's uncertainty around the world, we in A.A. have a tremendous force in Concept I. We maintain the unity we enjoy by utilizing Concept I.

This is the love we have for our fellow members and for the principles on which our lives today are founded. "
