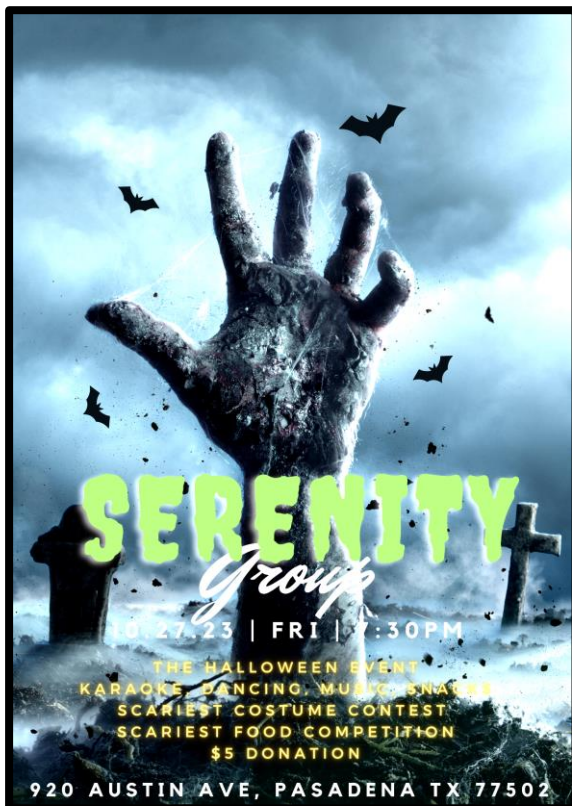

Videos should be 15 seconds minimum and up to three minutes maximum and focus on the experience of getting sober young. The videos can be in English, Spanish or French and must adhere to AA's 12 Traditions,



including anonymity (make sure no one is identifiable in the video).

Focus on the experience of getting sober young and try to reflect the diversity of the fellowship. Use stories young alcoholics can identify with.
