Finance Committee Floor Actions – Special Event Insurance

- Good practice and necessitated by recent experience
- San Jac already requires insurance for each of our rentals \$213
- About \$600 for entire SETA Convention 2025 with \$1 million coverage
- Suggest paying from general fund for 2025 Convention only because Convention's budget was already set and approved by the Finance Committee–unfair to make the Convention Committee juggle money already planned and perhaps spent

Motion 1 - Passed by Finance Committee, so presented to the body with a Second; *Passed by substantial unanimity with 60 in favor at Assembly (out of less than 71 voters present)*

The SETA Finance Committee makes a motion to require all events, where the Southeast Texas Assembly of Alcoholics Anonymous would be held liable (e.g. SETA Convention, SETA Assemblies, SWRAASA), carry special event liability insurance to protect from any losses stemming from personal injuries, property damage, medical payments, and lawsuits at an event.

Motion 2 - Passed by Finance Committee, so presented to the body with a Second; *Passed by substantial unanimity* _

The SETA Finance Committee makes a motion for the Area Assembly to carry the cost of the special event liability insurance for the 2025 SETA Convention. This one-time exception would allow the Area to be protected without adding to the already agreed upon budget for the upcoming convention.
